

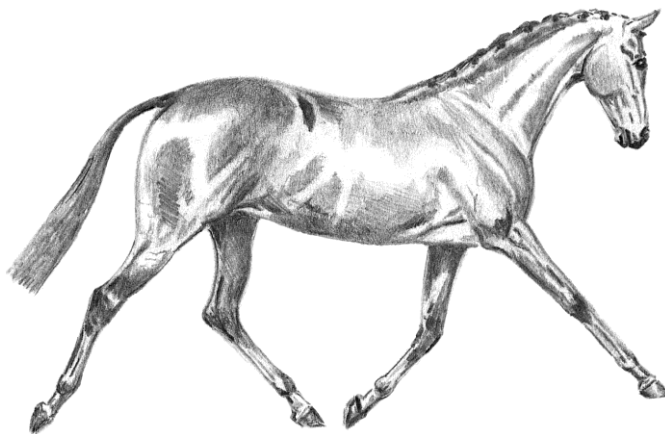

Important Information

Pre-Entries: **Postal:** Thursday 13th July; **Online:** Monday 17th July
Late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.

Finals: Ponies qualifying for finals must submit a qualification card when entering. If pre-entering online please post your qualification card to the office. If entering on the day please bring your card with you to the secretary's office or post it to the Stoneleigh office no later than **Monday 24th July** so your name may be added to the list of qualified ponies.

On the Day The Secretary's office will be open during the following times for on-the-day entries for all classes:

Monday: 4.00pm - 7.00pm

Wednesday: 6.30am - 7.00pm

Tuesday: 6.30am - 7.00pm

Thursday: 6.30am - Close of Show

On the day entries may be made by cash or card. Cheques cannot be accepted. Please allow good time between making an on the day entry and your class, particularly at peak times. Refunds will not be awarded for missed classes.

Prices: Prices in brackets reflect on-the-day prices where applicable. "Misc" classes include pairs, Concours d'Elegance and fancy dress. Junior refers to any class in Gloucester ring on Tuesday, the Young Handler and Junior M&M In Hand on Thursday.

Stabling: Please note that Temporary Stabling will be divided into two blocks, Brown Stables situated in brown car park and Yellow Stables situated in Yellow car park. Please select your preference at time of booking. Transfers may not be possible. Temporary stables may be booked online or on paper at the following rates:

One Night: £50 Two Nights: £70 Duration: £100

Permanent stabling may be booked on paper or over the phone **ONLY** and is for the duration of the show strictly on a first come first served at the following rates:

Sponsors: £100 Non-Sponsors: £125

Day Stabling: Stabling not pre-booked may be available for the DAY for only £20. This can be secured on the day with the Show Office only and cannot be guaranteed in any way.

Please vacate all temporary stables by 3pm.

Duration and Permanent stables are available between 12pm Monday and 3pm Thursday. One and Two Night stables will be available from 5pm on the first night booked until 3pm on the last day of booking.

Refunds: Once an entry has been received no refunds of entry fees will be offered without the production of a vet/doctors certificate and will be subject to a £20 administration charge. Stabling will not be refunded but may be resold prior to the show at cost, provided the NPS is notified who will be taking the stable.

Exercise In the interests of safety ponies may only be exercised in designated Exercise Areas. These areas, for safety purposes, may be steward-monitored at peak times. Exercising is forbidden in the show/collecting rings (unless under the direction of a safety steward), as is tampering with or jumping WHP fences.

Camping/ Caravans: Camping and caravan passes are available at £5 each in advance when making entries or through the office. There will be dedicated camping areas. Some limited camping space with horse boxes may be available at the discretion of the stewards on the day; however these will not be permitted near the stables due to space and health and safety reasons. The decision of the parking attendants and stewards is final. Each pitch is up to 6m wide.

Parking: While generators are permitted at Three Counties they MUST be switched off between 11.00pm and 6.00am. A “quiet” area where generators are not permitted will be arranged; please ask a parking steward on arrival if you wish to be parked there. Anyone parking any vehicle (including private cars) without the advice and permission of NPS officials and refusing to move it to a safe area risks wheel clamping. A fine of £100, payable to the NPS office, will be required to effect release.

Vaccinations: Equine Influenza vaccinations are not compulsory at Three Counties Showground. The NPS recommends regular vaccination as prescribed by your veterinary surgeon. Any ponies showing signs of a cough or illness may be removed from the showground.

All prize money (with the exception of the Champions and Reserve Champions of the classes in bold in the above table which will be forwarded after the show.) must be collected during the show. Any money not collected will be deemed a donation to the Society and will not be forwarded after the show.

Prizes in kind: Many sponsors kindly offer prizes in-kind. Prizes in-kind are awarded due to the generosity of our sponsors. However the NPS does not accept responsibility for their quality, durability, safety or suitability. Prizes will not be forwarded on after the show and are forfeited if not claimed.

Trophies: Many of our trophies are available for winners to take home and retain for one year but we ask competitors to be understanding when this is not possible due to the value or fragility of the trophy concerned. Winners will be able to request trophies on the day to have extra photos taken. Trophies which may be taken home are subject to a small fee to cover insurance and must be returned to the Society cleaned and engraved by 1st June the following year.

Hats: **Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/ specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages. All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.**
In addition the new BS/EN standard will be allowed, once approved with the finalised number being advised in due course. Please note that from the 1st January 2017 the list of standards no longer includes BS/EN1384: 1996 or 2012 (or prior year suffix). The new European standard will be allowed once finalised and will be advised in due course. Handlers of ponies in In-Hand Classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets one of the above standards.

Litter/Manure Three Counties Showground disposes of all biodegradable stable manure onto farmland. You are asked to place all non-biodegradable domestic rubbish such as plastic bags, broken buckets, baling string, dog waste etc. in the receptacles provided by the Three Counties Showground.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All classes, unless otherwise stated, are subject to NPS rules and regulations as outlined in the current rule book. In addition:

- All exhibits must be in possession of Equine Passports and be registered in the Stud Book or Register of their respective Breed or Type. Foals under 6 months old must have registration and passport applied for; Exmoor foals are exempt. **Entries must be made in the owner's name as shown in the passport.**
- In the case of a false pedigree being given on the entry form any prizes won will be forfeited.
- It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies correctly in the appropriate class. Ponies may be transferred on payment of a fee, except when measured out, once entries have been accepted.
- **Ridden and In Hand Stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker on their bridle in all NPS classes excluding Horse of the Year Show Qualifiers.** These are available from the Secretary's office at a charge of £2.00.
- Grooms are required to be of smart appearance and must wear a hat whilst in the ring.
- Mobile phones are **NOT** permitted in the Ring.
- In all Ridden Classes, **unless different rules are stated**, 6 selected ponies must be stripped, together with others at the Judge's discretion, but these need not necessarily be the first 6 ponies. **In ALL NPS Finals, ALL ANIMALS forward must be stripped.**
- Handlers of every pony/horse eligible for The Cuddy Supreme In Hand Championship will be given a qualifying card which must be handed to the Ring Steward when entering the ring in order to compete for the HOYS Qualifying round at the Show.
- **All exhibitors and persons admitted to the Show Ground shall be subject to the Rules, By Laws, Orders, Regulations and Conditions of the Council of the Society.**
- Ponies may only be ridden on the showground in tack appropriate to the class they are competing in that day. All areas of the showground will be monitored.

- Measuring will take place at the measuring box sited in Stable 1 of the permanent stables commencing at 7.00am until 10.00am on Wednesday 2nd August 2017. For all height measurements 1cm (1/4 of an inch) will be allowed for shoes. All exhibits in classes restricted by a height limit may be measured and issued with the appropriate veterinary measurement card. Adult ponies in possession of a current J.M.B. Annual or Full Certificate will not be measured but the Certificate MUST be produced. Any pony measured out will automatically be transferred to the next height class where possible. **Equine Passports will be required by the measuring officer to assist with identification.** The pony's class exhibit number will be required to aid identification. Your pony will not be measured unless you produce your number. (Late entries please note, make your entry prior to presenting your pony to the measuring box).
- **Any pony taking part will be liable to dope testing in accordance with the 2017 NPS Rule Book**

GENERAL REGULATIONS & SOCIETY'S POWERS

- The Show Committee Chairman reserves the right to change judges after publication of the Schedule. The Council of the Society reserves to itself by its Show Committee the sole and overriding power to interpret these and any other prescribed Conditions, Regulations and Bye-Laws, or the terms of any Prize List or Schedule of Show Conditions and to settle and determine all matters, questions or disputes in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with or incidental to the Show.
- Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their groom/assistants or riders and for the consequences of any conduct of such assistants. All persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to the orders of the Officials. There will be a zero tolerance policy regarding aggressive behaviour and any person(s) found being aggressive to any other competitor, volunteer or staff member will be removed from the showground immediately.
- Any animal not sufficiently under control shall be removed from the Show Ring immediately at the request of a Judge or Steward.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times whilst on the Showground. The Three Counties Society require dog waste to be picked up and disposed of with domestic waste, in a suitable container. Please do not place dog waste with stable manure. **PLEASE TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOUR DOG.**
- **Bicycles, hover boards and other propelled methods of transport are strictly prohibited.**

UNAUTHORISED USE OF STABLES - There will be a minimum fine of £100 levied on anyone who uses a stable without the authorisation of the Stable Managers. Ponies will not be released until this fine has been paid.

PROTESTS - Any member or exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any person or exhibits shall do so in writing to the Secretary and shall at the same time deposit the sum of £50. The protest shall be considered by a Ground Jury Panel. If on investigation the protest is not sustained, the deposit may be forfeited to the funds of the Society. All protests shall be delivered within an hour of the incident.

GENERAL DISPUTES - The Chairman of the Show Committee or an authorised deputy, in their absolute discretion may, without assigning any reason, refuse an entry or cancel any entry already accepted or may decline to admit to the Show Ground any animal or exhibitor or person or withhold any prize. Whenever under this regulation any entry is refused or cancelled, or any exhibit, exhibitor or person is refused admission or is removed, the fees paid for such entry may, at the discretion of the Show Chairman or an authorised deputy, be refunded and if refunded, shall be accepted by the exhibitor or intending exhibitor in full satisfaction of all claims against the Society, its officers, servants or assistants.

The Chairman of the Show Committee shall have power to suspend or remove from the Show Ground, at the expense and risk of the person responsible, their stock or property, or anyone who shall infringe any of the Conditions or Regulations of the Society or who shall refuse to comply with any instructions given by the Stewards, or whose conduct shall in the opinion of the Chairman of the Show Committee be derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the Society or its members, or who in the opinion of the Chairman of the Show Committee have been guilty of any act or omission involving cruelty or unnecessary suffering to, or neglect of, any animal, and all forfeits, fees and charges shall be due by the person responsible before any removal from the Show Ground takes place.

Neither the Society nor any of its officers, staff or assistants shall be in any way responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatever) to exhibitors or their servants or assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought into the Show Ground, or on premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same, or otherwise for anything else in connection with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Society's Show or Shows or to the Conditions, Regulations or Bye-Laws prescribed by the Society in relation thereto.

Each exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decisions of the Judges and officials of the Show who shall have power in their absolute and controlled discretion to withhold any trophy or prize for want of merit or lack of competition in any class or otherwise howsoever.

CLAIMS - Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal (including the spread of any infection or contagious disease) or article exhibited or introduced to the Show Ground by him or her and shall indemnify the Society and its Officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising out of his or her entry or entries in the Show.

AFFILIATIONS

VETERAN HORSE SOCIETY – DIRECT QUALIFIER 2017. FINAL 504-511

Open to members and non-members

VHS Supreme Final qualification. Competitors placed Champion and Reserve in both the ridden and in-hand Championship will qualify for their corresponding age category at the VHS Supreme Final, to be held September 2017 at Arena UK.

If the competitor has already qualified or does not wish to attend, they must refuse the qualification card and pass it down the line **on the day no lower than 6th place**. Entries for the VHS Supreme Final must be made within 21 days of qualification date. All competitors must become full VHS members in order to enter the Supreme Final.

Qualification can be made on-line or by sending a copy of the 'Golden Ticket' with Supreme Application, available from the VHS Website.

HIGHLAND PONY SOCIETY

All competing Highland pony stallions in affiliated shows (In Hand, Ridden, WHP etc) aged 4yrs and over should be licensed with the Highland Pony Society."

National Pony Society Working Dressage Group

The following qualifications are available.

1. Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds not exceeding 138cm
2. Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds exceeding 138cm
3. Registered British Riding Ponies
4. Part Bred Horses/Ponies registered with their appropriate Native Breed Part Bred Stud Book – including Part Bred Arab ponies over stamped in the British Riding Pony Stud book and ponies registered with the British Sports Pony Stud Book. Please note Part Bred Native ponies and Sports ponies over stamped within the British Riding Pony & Stud Book may only compete in one section per season.
5. Highest placed Mini rider aged under 12 years on 1st January 2017
6. Highest placed Junior rider under 18 years on 1st January 2017

The two highest placed ponies in each section at each qualifying show will qualify for the 2018 Final and also be eligible to be chosen to represent their Breed, NPS Area or other team in the Team Challenge which will be incorporated into the 2018 Championship Final.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW- GENERAL WORDING

All Horse of the Year Show (HOYS) qualifiers are also subject to the following conditions:

- These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk.
- These classes are qualifying classes for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 4th – 8th October 2017. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.
- Riders and Owners must be members of NPS, Ponies (UK), The Showing Register or BSPS. Riders and Owners competing in M&M classes may also be a member of their respective breed society.
- All classes excluding the Cuddy, plaited WHP and M&M WHP will be marked in the following way
Marks will be awarded as follows:

Manners & Way of Going - 50 Marks Maximum; Conformation, Type & Freedom of Action – 50 Marks Maximum. In the case of equality, the horse with the highest Manners & Way of Going mark will be deemed the winner. If there is still equality at this point then the judges' decision will be final. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

Cuddy Supreme In Hand

The Champion of each light horse/pony section will be eligible to compete in this class provided it has not already won a qualifying round in 2017. If the Champion has already qualified or is ineligible then the Reserve Champion of that section may come forward, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified or are ineligible then the section will not be represented in this qualifying round.

Foal champions are not eligible. Geldings Four years old and over are not eligible. Each section represented must consist of a minimum of 2 classes and a Championship. There will be no direct entry into the Cuddy Supreme In Hand Championship Qualifier; all animals must be a section Champion or Reserve Champion as applicable.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the qualification will not pass down to the Reserve in the 2nd and subsequent sections.

Championship: Cuddy Supreme In-Hand Horse of the Year Show qualifying competition

Prizes: Champion: £125.00

Horse of the Year Show Cuddy Champion Rosette & Sash

Reserve: £75.00

Horse of the Year Show Cuddy Reserve Champion Rosette

Prize money will be paid out after the Final by Grandstand Media Ltd to all Champions who come forward at the Horse of the Year Show. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.



Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st -3rd August 2017.

The first 3 ponies, owned by an NPS member, in each of the qualifying classes will go forward to the final. Where these ponies have already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than fifth place.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) may wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. All qualifying ponies will receive a qualification card. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeited.

NOISE PREVENTION is strictly governed by Three Counties Association in conjunction with their contracted audio company and sound system. Whilst we have asked for all areas of showground to be covered by the Public Address System there are some areas which unfortunately cannot be reached. **IT IS THE EXHIBITORS RESPONSIBILITY** to make sure that they can hear all announcements and reach their Ring on time. No Complaints will be heard or refunds made for missed classes.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPETITOR TO ENSURE THEY HAVE ENTERED THE CORRECT CLASS.

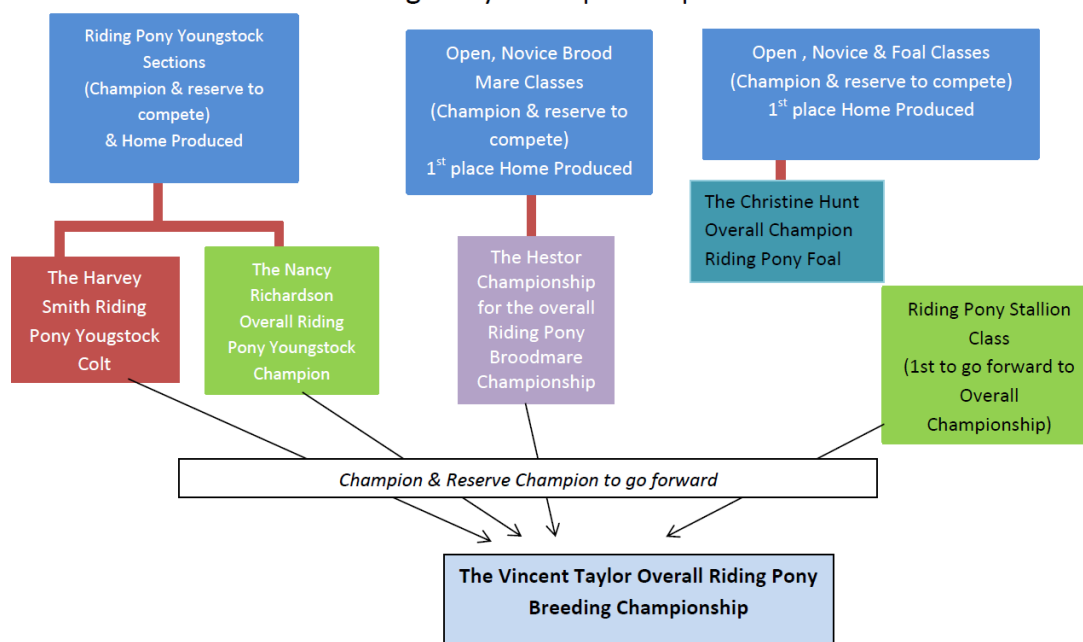
