National Pony Society Spring Festival Three Counties Showground, Malvern 24th April 2021

Dear Competitor

Please find enclosed your entry confirmation, back number, timetable, Working Hunter start list, Dressage times, entry passes and vehicle pass.

Due to the current Covid restrictions, you will only be able to gain entry to the showground with the correct entry and vehicle pass therefore please ensure you bring them with you.

KEY COVID INFORMATION

- Full Covid protocols will be in place. Please abide by the rules set out by the venue.
- Anyone who is symptomatic or suspects they have been exposed to the virus should not take part in any activities and must remain at home.
- <u>No</u> entries or substitutions will be accepted on the day. Pre-entries only.
- Only competitors who have pre-booked stabling will be allowed to access the stable area. You will not be able to book any stabling on the day.
- For competitors stabling on Friday night, it will be necessary to remain in your bubbles and to take all necessary social distancing measures required under the government guidance. This will be monitored and any competitor found to be breaching the social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the showground.
- Class sizes have been limited in line with The Showing Council blueprint for showing, with the exception of WHP classes.
- No animals will be stripped for conformation except in Horse of the Year Show and RIHS qualifiers.
- In HOYS and RIHS qualifiers Grooms may only enter the ring at an appropriate time to play their role when indicated by the steward; Grooms should not remain in the ring any longer than is absolutely necessary. Only 1 groom may enter the ring per exhibitor. The groom must wear a face covering at all times when in the ring.
- In the line up all competitors must remain 2 metres apart.
- All one way systems on the showground must be adhered to including when returning to the stable area.
- No equipment should be shared on the day between exhibitors or officials.
- Competitors are asked to remain in the vicinity of their own lorry when not competing and to leave the showground as soon as possible after the completion of your class and championship.
- Competitors must take all their litter home due to the risk of contamination.
- A Rider must not ride for multiple stables at a single show.
- When social distancing is not possible, face coverings MUST be worn i.e. stewards, medical teams, grooms who do not reside with the rider.

ACCESS TO THE SHOWGROUND – All competitor must enter via Yellow Gate. The show will open at 6.30am on Saturday morning unless you are stabling overnight (please see below). THERE WILL BE NO "HOLDING" AREA. <u>DO NOT</u> ARRIVE BEFORE THIS TIME.

Once cleared to progress through Yellow Gate, you must park as indicated by the parking team. Under no circumstances will you be able to reserve a space next to you for any late arriving friends or family.

STABLING - From 12th April 2021 overnight stays are permitted in your horsebox with stabling offered in order to support any overnight stay. For competitors stabling on Friday night, it will be necessary to remain in your bubbles and to take all necessary social distancing measures required under the government guidance. This will be monitored and any competitor found to be breaching the social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the showground.

Gates will be open from 6pm on Friday evening until 9pm for those competitors who have pre booked stabling.

Your stable number has been pre-allocated and can be found highlighted on the attached stable plan. You **must** use the stable allocated to you. No bedding is provided so please bring your own.

WARM UP AREAS – Please note that you will only be able to enter the designated warm up area 30 minutes before the start of your class. No access to the warm up area will allowed before this time.

WORKING HUNTER – Classes will be jumped in drawn order as per the enclosed list. The drawn order is designed to ensure the smooth running of all classes and minimise the number of competitors waiting in the collecting area. No jumping out of order will be permitted. An allocated Official will be based in the WHP warm up area to raise and lower the practise fence as required. This is to ensure minimum contact with the equipment.

DRESSAGE – Please note that all dressage classes will now be run in Hanley Swan ring as indicated on the map below.

MEDICAL There will be both fully qualified paramedics and medical attendants on site.

NUMBERS & ENTRIES- Your back number is enclosed in this letter. Please ensure you bring it with you. Please also find enclosed a list of classes you have entered; please check these thoroughly as changes cannot be made on the day.

PASSES – Please ensure you bring your vehicle pass to be allowed entry to the showground. You will also find enclosed the appropriate of competitor admission passes as per your completed Track & Trace form.

SECRETARY'S OFFICE - This will be located in the Teme Hall but access will be strictly limited and face coverings must be worn if coming into the office.

PRIZE MONEY - Prize money will be paid via bank transfer after the show. All competitors eligible to receive prize money will be contacted by the NPS Office after the show.

MARK SHEETS – No mark sheets will be displayed at the show. They will be available to view on the NPS social media pages later in the day or on the website the week after the show.

CATERING – Happy Herefords will provide on site catering. Please ensure you observe all social distancing requirements around their unit.

PHOTOGRAPHY – 1^{st} Class Photography will be on site and all images can be purchased from their website after the show.

STRIPPING - In order to minimise the number of people entering a ring and to help the stewards ensure social distancing is maintained at all times, it has been agreed that no ponies will be stripped for conformation assessment in NPS qualifiers and Finals for 2021 only. This includes both flat ridden and WHP qualifiers. Ponies will be assessed for conformation with their saddles on (mounted) and this should include boots if worn. Please note that in HOYS and RI qualifiers it is mandatory for all ponies to be stripped.
