STABLING

Please note that whilst both NPS Members and Non Members can enter qualifying rounds ONLY the **3** highest placed QUALIFYING/LIFE MEMBERS in the first five will be eligible to qualify for the Final (Winter Final Qualifiers, Ridden SP/SHP Summer & Ottergayle excluded)

REMEMBER YOU CAN TAKE OUT YOUR NPS MEMBERSHIP ON THE DAY AND STILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR REDUCED ENTRY FEES, AND BE ABLE TO QUALIFY FOR SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIPS

VACCINATIONS – Subject to any additional restrictions placed by Three Counties Showground, Malvern.

Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes. For horses/ponies commencing their vaccinations from 1st January 2024. Two injections for primary vaccination, not less than 21 days and not more than 60 days apart, are required before being eligible to compete. A first booster injection must be given within 100-180 days after the second injection of primary vaccination. Subsequent booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than one year, commencing after the first booster injection; No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old.

GDPR

Information from entry forms will be stored on a secure server and the details of entries will be published in the catalogue (if applicable). Information will be passed to our printer solely for the purpose of formulating the catalogue. Results information, including photographs may be published (in printed form and online) both to the press, other societies and showing organisations and in the Society's publications. Information may be supplied to professional and regulatory bodies as necessary. We will not otherwise share your personal data with other third parties without your prior consent unless required to do so by law. The making of an entry is irrevocable consent for the storage and disclosure of information in this way.

PRIZES

At the discretion of the Chairman of the Show Committee; Classes which have less than 4 entries may be cancelled or amalgamated.

- Prize money will be awarded to the first 3 placed in the Horse of the Year Show Qualifying Rounds 1st £45; 2nd £20; 3rd £10
- Prize money will be awarded to the first 3 placed in the Royal International Horse Show M&M WHP Qualifying Rounds
 - 1st £40; 2nd £20; 3rd £10
- Prize money shall also be awarded to the first 3 placed in each section of the ridden Winter Championship Finals
 - 1st £30 2nd £15; 3rd £10 & £30.00 to the sponsored sections Champion and £15.00 to the Reserve
- Prize money shall also be awarded to the first 3 placed in each section of the in hand Winter Championship Finals.
 - 1st £22 2nd £12; 3rd £8 & £30.00 to the sponsored sections Champion and £15.00 to the Reserve

PRIZE MONEY MUST BE COLLECTED FROM THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE, **ON THE DAY** OF THE SHOW. PRIZE MONEY NOT COLLECTED WILL BE DEEMED A DONATION TO THE SOCIETY.

ROSETTES

Rosettes to 10th place will be awarded in the Horse of the Year Show qualifying rounds, Royal International qualifying rounds and Winter Championship Finals.

In all other classes rosettes will be awarded to 6th place.

PROTESTS

Any member or exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any person or exhibits shall do so in writing to the Secretary and shall at the same time deposit the sum of <u>£50</u>. The protest shall be considered by a Ground Jury Panel, the members of which have been elected by the Society's Show Committee. If on investigation the protest is not sustained, the deposit may be forfeited to the funds of the Society. All protests not delivered within an hour of the incident will not be considered.

GENERAL DISPUTES

The Chairman/Vice Chairman of the Show Committee, in their absolute discretion may, without assigning any reason, refuse an entry or cancel any entry already accepted or may decline to admit to the Showground any animal or exhibitor or person or withhold any prize. Whenever under this regulation any entry is refused or cancelled, or any exhibit, exhibitor or person is refused admission or is removed, the fees paid for such entry may, at the discretion of the Show Chairman/Vice Chairman, be refunded and if refunded, shall be accepted by the exhibitor or intending exhibitor in full satisfaction of all claims against the Society, its officers, servants or assistants.

The Chairman/Vice Chairman of the Show Committee shall have power to suspend or remove from the Showground, at the expense and risk of the person responsible, their stock or property, or anyone who shall infringe any of the Conditions or Regulations of the Society or who shall refuse to comply with any instructions given by the Stewards, or whose conduct shall in the opinion of the Chairman/Vice Chairman of the Show Committee be derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the Society or its members, or who in the opinion of the Chairman/Vice Chairman of the Show Committee have been guilty of any act or omission involving cruelty or unnecessary suffering to, or neglect of, any animal, and all forfeits, fees and charges shall be due by the person responsible before any removal from the Showground takes place.

Neither the Society nor any of its officers, servants, or assistants shall be in any way responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatever) to exhibitors or their servants or assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought into the Showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same, or otherwise for anything else in connection with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Society's Show or Shows or to the Conditions, Regulations or Bye-Laws prescribed by the Society in relation thereto.

Each exhibitor shall abide by and accept as Final the decisions of the Judges and Officials of the Show who shall have power in their absolute and controlled discretion to withhold any cup or prize for want of merit or lack of competition in any class or otherwise.

CLAIMS

Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal (including the spread of any infection or contagious disease) or article exhibited or introduced to the Showground by him or her and shall indemnify the Society and its Officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising out of his or her entry or entries in the Show.

GENERAL RULES & SOCIETY'S POWERS

All NPS qualifying rounds and finals to be judged under the Rules of the National Pony Society.

The Show Committee reserves the right to change judges after publication of the Show Schedule. Where possible, any changes will be sent to competitors following the close of entries, posted on the Website and Social Media. The Show Committee reserves the right to add or remove classes as deemed necessary.

The Council of the Society reserves to itself by its Show Committee the sole and overriding power to interpret these and any other prescribed Conditions, Regulations and Bye-Laws, or the terms of any Prize List or Schedule of Show Conditions and to settle and determine all matters, questions or disputes in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with or incidental to their Show or Shows.

Any animal not sufficiently under control shall be removed from the Show Ring immediately at the request of a Judge, Steward, Society official or member of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their grooms or assistants or riders and for the consequences of any conduct of such servants or assistants and all persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to the orders of the Judge, Steward, Society official or member of the Show Committee.

In all Ridden Classes, unless different rules are stated with the classification, 6 ponies <u>must</u> be stripped and others at the judge's discretion, but not necessarily the first 6. In Finals all ponies forward MUST be stripped.

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages.

Hat Standards accepted as of 1st January 2024 are as follows: PAS015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 & 2023, SNELL E2016 onwards, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards.

Hats meeting more than one standard: Some hats are badged with two or more standards. As long as a hat contains at least one compliant hat standard, then it is deemed suitable for use under NPS rules, even if it is additionally labelled with an older or out of date standard.

Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull cap/riding hat that meets one of the above standards.

ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT EXHIBITORS HAVE READ AND UNDERSTOOD THE RULES AND REGULATIONS AS LAID DOWN IN THE 2024 NPS RULEBOOK.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All exhibits must be registered in the Stud Book or Register of their respective Breed or Type.

All Stallions and Colts two years old and over must hold a current Stallion licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society. Two and three year old Colts are to be judged as likely to make future Stallions. In Hand stallions and colts 2 years old or over must be adequately bitted and are advised to display a stallion bridle marker available from the NPS office or from any other society.

In the case of a false pedigree being given on the entry form any prizes won will be forfeited.

Brood Mares must be four years old and over and must be shown in the ring with foal at foot which must be at least four weeks old on day of show. A Barren Mare is a mare without a foal at foot in the current season. Mares with live foals born in the current year cannot be entered in Ridden or Working Hunter Pony classes.

It is forbidden to administer any stimulant or sedative or any other substance to a pony or cause one to be administered in any way whatsoever with the object of influencing the pony's performance in the Show Ring. The Society reserves the right to conduct Dope Tests in accordance with NPS Rule Book.

In all classes animals must be sound and healthy. No Veterinary inspection will be required except when considered necessary by the judges or on a protest being lodged. The owner of an animal rejected may, upon application in writing to the Secretary, be furnished with a copy of the Veterinary Certificate. JMB Rules will apply in the event of any dispute relating to the height of a pony.

All exhibitors and persons admitted to the Showground shall be subject to the Rules, Bye Laws, Orders, Regulations and Conditions of the Council of the Society.

Handlers of Stallions and Colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. There is no age limit for riders in Mountain & Moorland Ridden and Working Hunter Pony classes with the exception of Stallions and Colts in that riders must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds (Shetland, Exmoor, Dartmoor, Welsh A and Welsh B) and their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year for large breeds (Highland, Dales, Fell, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh C and Welsh D). Riders of stallions in Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony classes must have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year for ponies 128cms (12.2hh) or under, and their 14th birthday when riding stallions exceeding 128cms (12.2hh).

Any owner who has not received their membership card in the post must collect a letter of dispensation from the secretary's office prior to the commencement of the class.

Please note the following regulations in the interests of safety:-

- It is the owner's due diligence to ensure that horses and ponies are not left unattended whilst tied to the side of trailers or lorries.
- Exhibitors are not allowed to set up corrals in the lorry park.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times whilst on the Showground. The Three Counties Society
 require dog waste to be picked up and disposed of with domestic waste, in a suitable container. Please do not
 place dog waste with stable manure. PLEASE TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOUR DOG.
- Bicycles, scooters, skateboards etc. are not allowed within the Showground.
- Ponies must only be exercised in the designated areas and must at all times proceed at a walk on the roadways.
 Ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes may only be ridden on the showground in tack appropriate to the class they are competing in that day.
- Sleeping or cooking in the stables is not permitted.
- Please obey the instructions of the Show Committee, Stable Management Team or any other Official at all times.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds

These classes are judged under the Rules of the National Pony Society. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part Breds are not eligible.

<u>Summer Qualifiers</u> - Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life Members are eligible to qualify for the Final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ August 2024.

The first three ponies in each class, providing they are owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life Member, will qualify for the Final. Qualification may go no lower than 5th place. The owner of the pony's membership card must be produced in the ring to receive qualification.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship – Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule Book) **MUST** wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS Qualifying/ Life Members, are then eligible to qualify for the Final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

<u>Winter Qualifiers</u> - In each class the **three highest placed ponies**, **not already qualified**, **within the first six places**, **will qualify.** Winnings in the 2023/2024 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2024 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

Working Hunter Pony - Riders may only ride one pony in each class in the NPS/Simons Family & Marbeth Stud Training Stakes and the NPS/Supreme Products RIHS M&M WHP qualifying classes.

NPS Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony Qualifying Rounds

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part breds are not eligible unless overstamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook section or the Ridden Register. Ponies must be plaited.

Qualifying rounds are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members. In Hand classes only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life Members are eligible to qualify for the Final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ August 2024. Ridden classes - the owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition or to qualify but the owner must be a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final.

The first 3 ponies in each class will qualify for the Final. Qualification may go no lower than 5th place. The pony's owner's membership card (in hand classes) must be produced in the ring to receive qualification.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship – Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule Book) **MUST** wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS Qualifying/ Life Members, are then eligible to qualify for the Final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

<u>NPS/ ASSENDONS FREESTYLE TO MUSIC QUALIFIERS HELD AT THIS SHOW –</u> Champion and Reserve M&M Open Ridden (CH2) and Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony Open Ridden (CH32) qualify. If the Champion and/or Reserve Champion have already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition or to qualify but the owner must be a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final.

NPS Silver Medal Championships

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the Final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show from $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ August 2024



Competitors are offered a variety of classes which can be entered separately or combined to form a one day event style competition. Dressage, show jumping and 'cross country' will be offered across the day. The cross country class will be run in Hereford Ring A, utilising the natural obstacles and a mixture of WHP and arena eventing style fences. These can be entered as

- Individual classes (either show jumping, dressage OR cross country)
- Combined Training (one show jumping class AND one dressage class)
- One day event (one show jumping, one dressage AND one cross country class)


