GENERAL RULES

Ponies in M&M classes must be registered in the appropriate studbook

In Hand Classes – Please submit your photo entry with the pony stood up correctly and the photo taken from the side.

Ridden & Dressage Classes – Please submit your photo entry of your pony under saddle in trot or canter, with the exception of first ridden and lead rein classes when the pony may be shown in trot only.

WHP Classes – Please submit your photo entry of your pony under saddle jumping a suitable fence.

Ensure your pony is photographed on a fairly plain background which does not detract from the pony.

Please ensure you have obtained and hold written copyright on all photographs submitted for inclusion.

The same picture can be used as your entry in more than one class

Anyone under the age of 18 appearing in a photo must have parent or guardian approval

By submitting a photo to this show you are deemed to have agreed that the National Pony Society may reproduce the photograph on the NPS and Mole Valley Farmers social media pages and website and that your address details can be passed to Mole Valley Farmers and Supreme Products for dispatch of your prize.

NPS Members - Free entry to all ponies who are owned by current members of the National Pony Society. Membership numbers must be stated with entry. Members must email their photo entry to shows@nationalponysociety.com and include the following details in the email:

Show Pony In Hand

Open to registered British Riding Ponies, not to exceed 148cms at maturity.

1. Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding not to exceed 148cms at maturity
2. 2 & 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding not to exceed 148cms at maturity
3. Mare, Gelding or Stallion 4 years old or over not to exceed 148cms

Show Hunter Pony In Hand

Open to registered British Riding Ponies, not to exceed 153cms at maturity.

4. Yearling, Colt, Filly or Gelding not to exceed 153cms at maturity
5. 2 & 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding not to exceed 153cms at maturity
6. Mare, Gelding or Stallion 4 years old or over not to exceed 153cms

Mountain & Moorland In Hand

7. Youngstock Colt, Filly or Gelding Small Breeds
8. Youngstock Colt, Filly or Gelding Large Breeds
9. 4 year old and over. Small Breeds
10. 4 year old and over. Large Breeds

RIDDEN CLASSES

11. Dressage – Novice/Prelim

Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings four year old and over, in possession of an equine passport but no specific registration or breed society criteria. Ponies' manes may be plaited at competitor discretion.

Open Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein

12. Lead Rein – Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Open Mountain & Moorland First Ridden

13. First Ridden – Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Tiny Tots Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein & First Ridden

14. Lead Rein: Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider must have attained their 3rd birthday but not their 7th birthday by the 1st of January in the current year
15. First Ridden: Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider must be in the first year of First Ridden classes & must not have attained their 10th birthday by the 1st of January in the current year

Mountain & Moorland Open Ridden

Stallions, Mares and Geldings five years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book.

16. Small Breeds
17. Large Breeds

Mountain & Moorland Novice Ridden

Stallions, Mares and Geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book.

Ponies not to have been placed first in any Ridden M&M class (excluding Leading Rein or First Ridden) before 1st January in the current season.

18. Small Breeds
19. Large Breeds

Junior Ridden Mountain & Moorland

Mares and Geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book.

20. Junior Ridden. Rider not to have attained their 18th birthday by the 1st January in the current year.

Show Pony & Show Hunter Pony Lead Rein & First Ridden

Stallions, Mares and Geldings four years old and over registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part breds are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register.

21. Lead Rein - Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony. Mares and Geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms (12.0hh). Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 8th birthday (SP) or 9th (SHP) before the 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.
22. First Ridden - Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony. Mares and Geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms (12.0hh). Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Tiny Tots Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony Lead Rein & First Ridden

23. Tiny Tots Lead Rein Pony, Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over not exceeding 122cms. Rider must have attained their 3rd birthday but not their 5th birthday by the 1st January in the current year.

24. Tiny Tots First Ridden Pony, Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over not exceeding 122cms. Rider must not have attained their 8th birthday by the 1st January in the current year.

Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony Open Ridden

Stallions, Mares and Geldings four years old and over registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register.

25. Show Ponies not exceeding 148cms. Rider any age
26. Show Hunter Ponies not exceeding 153cms. Rider any age
27. Intermediate Show Riding Type or Show Hunter Type, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cm. Rider any age.

Mountain & Moorland and Plaited Amateur Ridden

28. M&M – Small Breed
29. M&M – Large Breed
30. Plaited

WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Mountain & Moorland Novice Working Hunter Pony

Stallions, Mares and Geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book.

31. Novice M&M WHP

Open Plaited Working Hunter Pony

Open to Mares, Geldings and Stallions (except classes 59 and 60 – Mares and Geldings only), four years old and over, in possession of an equine passport but no specific registration or breed society criteria. Ponies' manes must be plaited.

32. Plaited WHP, not exceeding 158cms.
33. Nursery Stakes, not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
34. Cradle Stakes, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Open M&M Working Hunter Pony

Stallions, Mares and Geldings five years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book.

35. Open M&M WHP

First Ridden M&M Working Hunter Pony

First Ridden WHP. Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over, not exceeding 128cms. Part bred are not eligible. Riders must have attained their 5th birthday but not their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Riders not to have qualified for HOYS or the RIHS M&M WHP Finals on any pony prior to the 1st January in the current year.

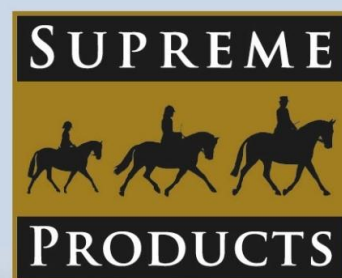
