Should the regulations change, then entries will be accepted with the exception of WPCS Bronze Medal Classes

The bedding store will be open at the following times: Monday: 12pm-9pm Tuesday: 8am-9.00pm Wednesday: 8am-TBC Thursday: 8am -12.00pm In the interests of safety ponies may only be exercised in designated Exercise Areas. These areas, for Exercise safety purposes, may be steward-monitored at peak times. Exercising is forbidden in the show/ collecting rings (unless under the direction of a safety steward), as is tampering with or jumping WHP fences. Camping/ Camping and caravan passes are available at £5 each in advance when making entries or **Caravans:** through the office. Some limited camping space with horse boxes may be available at the discretion of the Security Team on the day; however these will not be permitted near the stables due to space and health and safety reasons. The decision of the Security Team is final. Each pitch is up to 6m wide. There is NO HOOK UP available on the showground. **Parking:** While generators are permitted at Three Counties they MUST be switched off between **11.00pm** and 6.00am. A "quiet" area where generators are not permitted will be arranged; please ask a parking steward on arrival if you wish to be parked there. Anyone parking any vehicle (including private cars) without the advice and permission of NPS officials and refusing to move it to a safe area risks wheel clamping. A fine of £100, payable to the NPS office, will be required to effect release.

Vaccinations – Equine Influenza

Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes. Two injections for primary vaccination, not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart, are required before being eligible to compete. A first booster injection must be given within seven months after the second injection of primary vaccination. Subsequent booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than **one year**, commencing after the first booster injection; No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old.

Forgotten passport. Any horse without a passport will be sent home (plus travel companions).

<u>Unvaccinated companion horse</u>. Passports and vaccination records in accordance with the above rules must be carried for all horses on board any vehicle. Any horses without passports and compliant vaccination records will be asked to leave the site, along with any others which they may have travelled with.

Only primary course given. This is fine, as long as the horse has had the first two injections that make up the primary course, and the second injection was given within the last six months.

Primary course given, but first booster (due within seven months) has not yet been given. Fine if second injection was less than six months ago.

We thank all members and competitors for their cooperation with the equine influenza rules and remind all competitors to please make sure that all horses' passports are available for checking on arrival at the showground.

MICROCHIPPING

Microchipping of all horses is a legal requirement in England, Scotland and Wales and are therefore a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies (excluding foals at foot) competing in NPS affiliated classes from 2021 onwards. Microchip numbers must be submitted to the relevant Passport Issuing Organisation via the relevant registration forms. It is also a legal requirement to inform the passport issuing studbook of any change of ownership or death within 30 days. Please note there is no date set for Northern Ireland to introduce this rule.

Any money not collected will be deemed a donation to the Society and will not be forwarded after the show.

Prizes inMany sponsors kindly offer prizes in-kind. Prizes in-kind are awarded due to the generositykind:of our sponsors. However the NPS does not accept responsibility for their quality, durability, safety or
suitability. Prizes will not be forwarded on after the show and are forfeited if not claimed.

- **Trophies:** Many of our trophies are available for winners to take home and retain for one year but we ask competitors to be understanding when this is not possible due to the value or fragility of the trophy concerned. Winners will be able to request trophies on the day to have extra photos taken. Trophies which may be taken home are subject to a small fee to cover insurance and must be returned to the Society cleaned and engraved by 1st June the following year.
- Hats:Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety
Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages. All PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384
2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. The
most recent updates to the list are the addition of SNELL E2016 and EN1384 (2017); the newest
version of the SNELL Standard is accepted to the lost; the newest version of the EN1384 Standard is
also accepted to the list.

Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets one of the above standards.

Litter/Manure Three Counties Showground disposes of all biodegradable stable manure onto farmland. You are asked to place all non-biodegradable domestic rubbish such as plastic bags, broken buckets, baling string, dog waste etc. in the receptacles provided by the Three Counties Showground.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All classes, unless otherwise stated, are subject to NPS rules and regulations as outlined in the current rule book. In addition:

- All exhibits <u>must</u> be in possession of Equine Passports and be registered in the Stud Book or Register of their respective Breed or Type and complying with the showing requirements of their breed society. Foals under 6 months old must have registration and passport applied for; Exmoor foals are exempt. Entries must be made in the owner's name as shown in the passport.
- In the case of a false pedigree being given on the entry form any prizes won will be forfeited.
- It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies correctly in the appropriate class. Ponies may be transferred on payment of a fee, except when measured out, once entries have been accepted.
- Ridden Stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker on their bridle in all NPS classes excluding Horse of the Year Show Qualifiers. For In Hand Stallions/Colts this remains advisory. These are available from the Secretary's office at a charge of £2.00.
- Grooms are required to be of smart appearance and must wear a hat whilst in the ring.
- No unauthorised use of mobile phones and/or earpieces in the ring.
- <u>In all NPS Ridden Classes, no ponies will be stripped for 2021 only.</u> Ponies competing in Horse of the Year Show ridden qualifiers will still be stripped for conformation assessment.
- Handlers of every pony/horse eligible for The Price Family Supreme In Hand Championship will be given a qualifying card which must be handed to the Ring Steward when entering the ring for the pre-judging in order to compete for the HOYS Qualifying round at the Show.
- All exhibitors and persons admitted to the Show Ground shall be subject to the Rules, By Laws, Orders, Regulations and Conditions of the Council of the Society.
- Ponies may only be ridden on the showground in tack appropriate to the class they are competing in that day. All areas of the showground will be monitored.
- All Exhibits MUST be in possession of an Equine Passport. This MUST accompany the Exhibit to the show. A class may be selected at Random and ALL EXHIBITS will be required to produce their passport for entry into the class.
- The NPS reserve the right to Measure any class. For all height measurements 1cm (1/4 of an inch) will be allowed for shoes. All exhibits in classes restricted by a height limit may be measured and issued with the appropriate veterinary measurement card. Adult ponies in possession of a current J.M.B. Annual or Full Certificate will not be measured but the Certificate MUST be produced. Any pony measured out will automatically be transferred to the next height class where possible. **Equine Passports will be required by the measuring officer to assist with identification.** The pony's class exhibit number will be required to aid identification. Your pony will not be measured unless you produce your number. (Late entries please note, make your entry prior to presenting your pony to the measuring box).

- <u>Please check the NPS Website & FaceBook page on Thursday 29th July for a list of classes to be measured.</u>
- Any pony/horse taking part will be liable to dope testing in accordance with the 2021 NPS Rule Book

GENERAL REGULATIONS & SOCIETY'S POWERS

- The Show Committee reserves the right to change judges after publication of the Show Schedule. <u>Where possible, any changes will be sent to competitors following the close of entries, posted on the Website and Social Media</u>. The Council of the Society reserves to itself by its Show Committee the sole and overriding power to interpret these and any other prescribed Conditions, Regulations and Bye-Laws, or the terms of any Prize List or Schedule of Show Conditions and to settle and determine all matters, questions or disputes in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with or incidental to the Show.
- Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their groom/assistants or riders and for the consequences of any conduct of such assistants. All persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to the orders of the Officials. There will be a zero tolerance policy regarding aggressive behaviour and any person(s) found being aggressive to any other competitor, volunteer or staff member will be removed from the showground immediately.
- Any animal not sufficiently under control shall be removed from the Show Ring immediately at the request of a Judge or Steward.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times whilst on the Showground. The Three Counties Society require dog waste to be picked up and disposed of with domestic waste, in a suitable container. Please do not place dog waste with stable manure. PLEASE TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOUR DOG.
- Bicycles, hover boards and other propelled methods of transport are strictly prohibited.

UNAUTHORISED USE OF STABLES - There will be a minimum fine of $\pounds 100$ levied on anyone who uses a stable without the authorisation of the Stable Manager. Ponies will not be released until this fine has been paid.

PROTESTS - Any member or exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any person or exhibits shall do so in writing to the Secretary and shall at the same time deposit the <u>sum of $\pounds 50$ </u>. The protest shall be considered by a Ground Jury Panel. If on investigation the protest is not sustained, the deposit may be forfeited to the funds of the Society. All protests shall be delivered within an hour of the incident.

GENERAL DISPUTES – The NPS reserves the right to refuse entries from any person who is under exclusion or suspension by any Breed, Livestock or Show organisation. The Chairman of the Show Committee or an authorised deputy, in their absolute discretion may, without assigning any reason, refuse an entry or cancel any entry already accepted or may decline to admit to the Show Ground any animal or exhibitor or person or withhold any prize. Whenever under this regulation any entry is refused or cancelled, or any exhibit, exhibitor or person is refused admission or is removed, the fees paid for such entry may, at the discretion of the Show Chairman or an authorised deputy, be refunded and if refunded, shall be accepted by the exhibitor or intending exhibitor in full satisfaction of all claims against the Society, its officers, servants or assistants.

The Chairman of the Show Committee shall have power to suspend or remove from the Showground, at the expense and risk of the person responsible, their stock or property, or anyone who shall infringe any of the Conditions or Regulations of the Society or who shall refuse to comply with any instructions given by the Stewards, or whose conduct shall in the opinion of the Chairman of the Show Committee be derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the Society or its members, or who in the opinion of the Chairman of the Show Committee have been guilty of any act or omission involving cruelty or unnecessary suffering to, or neglect of, any animal, and all forfeits, fees and charges shall be due by the person responsible before any removal from the Show Ground takes place.

Neither the Society nor any of its officers, staff or assistants shall be in any way responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatever) to exhibitors or their servants or assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought into the Showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same, or otherwise for anything else in connection with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Society's Show or Shows or to the Conditions, Regulations or By-Laws prescribed by the Society in relation thereto.

Each exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decisions of the Judges and officials of the Show who shall have power in their absolute and controlled discretion to withhold any trophy or prize for want of merit or lack of competition in any class or otherwise howsoever.

CLAIMS - Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal (including the spread of any infection or contagious disease) or article exhibited or introduced to the Showground by him or her and shall indemnify the Society and its Officials against all

actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising out of his or her entry or entries in the Show.

AFFILIATIONS

Exmoor Pony of the Year

Rosettes and qualifying cards are awarded for best youngstock (in hand), best adult (in hand) and best ridden. The final will take place at the EPS Midland Area Show on 22 August 2021. Competitors should return their qualifying cards to the Exmoor Pony Society.

The Marion Williams Bursary rosette and qualifying card will be awarded to the highest placed rider under 25 riding a registered Exmoor pony owned by a member of the Society. Competitors should return their qualifying cards to the Exmoor Pony Society.

Highland Pony Society - BRONZE MEDAL SHOW

All competing Highland pony stallions in affiliated shows (In Hand, Ridden, WHP etc.) aged 4yrs and over should be **licensed** with the Highland Pony Society.

Shetland Pony Studbook Society (only applicable to the Ridden Shetland Shearwater class and the Shetland in hand breed classes)

1. Classes must be confined to SPS-BS registered ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.

2. Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. All entire males aged 2 years and over must display a stallion disc.

3. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 yrs old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 yrs old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 yrs or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old or over. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

National Pony Society Working Dressage Group

The following qualifications are available.

1. Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds not exceeding 138cm ; 2. Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds exceeding 138cm ; 3. Registered British Riding Ponies ; 4. Part Bred Horses/Ponies registered with their appropriate Native Breed Part Bred Stud Book – including Part Bred Arab ponies over stamped in the British Riding Pony Stud book and ponies registered with the British Sports Pony Stud Book. ; 5. Highest placed Mini rider aged under 12 years on 1st January 2021; 6. Highest placed junior rider under 18 years on 1st January 2021

The two highest placed ponies in each section at each qualifying show will qualify for the 2022 Final.

The show is also affiliated to the British Connemara Pony Society, Dales Pony Society, Dartmoor Pony Society, Exmoor Pony Society, Fell Pony Society and New Forest Pony Breeding & Cattle Society.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW- GENERAL WORDING

All Horse of the Year Show (HOYS) qualifiers are also subject to the following conditions:

- These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk.
- These classes are qualifying classes for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 6th 10th October 2021. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

- Riders and Owners must be members of NPS, UKPH, The Showing Register or BSPS. Riders and Owners competing in M&M classes may also be a member of their respective breed society.
- Qualification for all plaited pony classes will go no lower than 5th place.
- Qualification for all M&M classes will go no lower than 3rd place.
- Qualification for Show Hunter classes will not go lower than 5th place.
- Qualification for the Working Hunter classes will not go lower than 3rd place.
- These classes are Horse of the Year Show qualifiers, all data given upon entry of these classes is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit www.grandstandentries.com.

For plaited pony classes 1-11, 24-25 and 28 marks will be awarded in the following way:

- Manners & Way of Going 50 Marks Maximum
- Conformation, Type & Freedom of Action 50 Marks Maximum
- In the case of equality, the pony with the highest Manners & Way of Going mark will be deemed the winner. If there is still equality at this point, then the judges' decision will be final.

For mountain and moorland classes 26-27, 133-134 & 282-293 marks will be awarded in the following way:

- Show, Freedom of Action 50 Marks Maximum
- Breed Type & Conformation 50 Marks Maximum
- In the case of equality the pony with the highest Show, Freedom of Action mark will be deemed the winner. If there is still equality at this point then the judges' decision will be final.

All Animals competing in Mountain and Moorland Ridden, Mountain and Moorland WHP and, Mountain and Moorland Junior Ridden and Mountain and Moorland Lead Rein and First Ridden classes will be required to be in possession of a current/valid JMB height certificate within 28 days of the notification of qualification from HOYS or by the closing date of HOYS entries, whichever is sooner. Failure to do so may result in qualification of the pony being removed, at the discretion of GML.

HOYS The Price Family Supreme In Hand

The following class is a qualifier for the Supreme In Hand Championship, N.E.C., Birmingham, 6th – 10th October 2021. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony In Hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses). The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete, provided it has not already won a qualifying round in 2021. Show Hunter Pony Breeding, Show Pony Youngstock, Show Pony Breeding. Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland & Welsh Sections A,B,C & D. Anglo/Part Bred Arab, Part Bred Welsh, Hacks, Riding Horse, Sports Pony In Hand, Part Bred Native In Hand, Home Produced Show Pony, Home Produced Show Hunter Pony & M&M Home Produced. If the Champion has already qualified or is ineligible then the Reserve Champion of that section may come forward, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified or are ineligible then the section will not be represented in this qualifying round.

Foal champions are not eligible. Geldings Four years old and over are not eligible. Each section represented must consist of a minimum of 2 classes and a Championship. There will be no direct entry into the Price Family Supreme In Hand Championship Qualifier; all animals must be a section Champion or Reserve Champion as applicable. In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the qualification will not pass down to the Reserve in the 2nd and subsequent sections.

<u>NPS Qualifying Rounds</u>: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of

the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register (for ridden ponies only); the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part breds are not eligible unless overstamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the Final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern. Ridden British Pony classes and the Ottergayle qualifiers do not require membership.



The first 3 ponies, owned by an NPS member, in each of the qualifying classes will go forward to the final. Where these ponies have already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than fifth place.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) may wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. All qualifying ponies will receive a qualification card. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeited.

Results Calculation:

The best two results of each rider/handler will count towards the team score, giving a total of 8 results to count.

Each team must include the result from at least one WHP, one in hand and one junior class.

Results from NPS Finals and HOYS qualifiers will not count towards the Area competition.

The final results will be calculated at 2pm on Thursday 5th August. Any classes running after this time will not count towards final placings.

Points are awarded as follows: 1st place = 10 points 2nd place = 8 points 3rd place = 6 points 4th place = 4 points 5th place = 2 points 6th place = 1 point

The winning Area will receive $\pounds 200$ prize money, the second placed Area $\pounds 125$, and the third placed Area $\pounds 75$. Rosettes will also be awarded to the first 6 teams.


Jennie Seymour NPS Young Judges Competition




