ACCESS TO THE SHOWGROUND

The Gates for the NPS Summer Championship show will open at 12 noon on Monday 1st August. Access to the Showground is through Yellow Gate only, apart from Sponsors who have a separate access point. Only lorries displaying an official uniquely numbered blue priority pass will be permitted to park in the Priority Parking area unless prior arrangement with the main NPS Office has been made. If wanting to park next to a friend, please arrive together as no spaces can be 'saved'. Please note that no cars will be permitted to park in the lorry parking areas but can unload before being moved to the designated car park.

THE GATES WILL BE OPENED AT 12 NOON ON MONDAY 1ST AUGUST
THERE WILL BE NO "HOLDING" AREA. **DO NOT** ARRIVE BEFORE THIS TIME.

The gates will be open at the following times ONLY:-

There will be no movement of Lorries outside these times.

Entries for most classes, including HOYS and Finals, can be taken on the day. In Hand Welsh A, B, C, D and Part Bred classes can only be pre entered. Please ensure you leave enough time before your class to make entries and return to the ring. Refunds will not be given for missed classes. Payment can be made by **CASH OR CARD ONLY**. Entries to Finals are only accepted from those competitors who present a qualification card or who are already on the list of qualified ponies.

“Misc” classes include pairs, Concours d’Elegance and fancy dress. Junior refers to any class in Worcester or the Dressage ring on Tuesday, the Young Handler and Junior M&M In Hand on Thursday.

PRIZE MONEY - Prize money may be collected from the show secretary’s office during opening hours on Tuesday & Wednesday and from 9am until 30minutes after the last class on Thursday.

With the exception of specific championships listed in the front of the catalogue, all prize money not collected at the show will be forfeited and considered a donation to the Society.

FEED AND BEDDING

A Forage & Bedding Store will be located to the right of Ledbury Ring. This is being managed on behalf of the NPS by volunteer officials. All forage and bedding that has been pre-ordered is listed on your packing letter. There may be some surplus available to purchase on the day which must be paid for in the Show Secretaries Office but this is not guaranteed. Please note stabling does NOT include bedding and there is no capacity for delivery to your stables so please arrange to collect yourself any bedding or forage you have ordered

CATERING – There will be a selection of food outlets on the showground

FODDER STORE – The store will be open at the following times:

NEWSAGENTS- A mobile shop on the Showground will sell cigarettes, newspapers, milk, bread and other food items.

LOCAL RESIDENTS - Three Counties Association ask for consideration to residents in the nearby villages early in the morning and have requested that we advise all exhibitors to plan journeys so that the outlying villages, i.e. Hanley Castle, Hanley Swan, Welland, Poolbrook and Malvern Wells are respected.

NOISE PREVENTION - This is strictly governed by Three Counties Association in conjunction with their contracted audio company and sound system. Whilst we have asked that all areas of the showground are covered by the Public Address System there are some areas that unfortunately cannot be reached. IT IS THE EXHIBITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY to make sure that they can hear announcements and get to their ring on time. No Complaints will be heard or refunds made for missed classes.

OVERNIGHT SECURITY & SAFEGUARDING – Please be advised that there will be security staff on site at all times overnight. Show Vice Chairman Jayne McAuliffe will be the safeguarding contact during the day and is based in the secretary's office. The security team will act as a first point of contact for any safeguarding concerns overnight.

CATALOGUES- Catalogues will be available for purchase at the show. Pre-entry numbers will also be posted online towards the end of July.

PHOTOGRAPHY SIGN - There will be a designated photography area located next to the 1st Class Images tradestand where competitors may arrange with the official photographers to have a commemorative picture taken next to the bespoke National Pony Society sign.

COMPETITORS STAYING ON SITE FOR THE NATIONAL WELSH SHOW – We will aim to keep any competitors wishing to remain on site for the National Welsh Show in the same permanent stables you have been allocated for Summer Champs. If you have booked temporary stables, you will be able to move into permanent stables for the National Welsh Show after 5pm on Thursday.

FILMING – Please be aware a film crew will be in attendance gathering material that will be used in the production of a video to promote the British Riding Pony.

FIT FOR THE FUTURE

Being reintroduced for 2022 is the Fit for the Future scheme. Judges will be asked in certain pre-arranged classes to select the pony that in their opinion is of the optimum condition. The owner of that pony will then receive a goody bag from our partners at Baileys Horse Feeds.

The team from Baileys will also be on site to offer helpful and impartial nutritional advice to help competitors maximise their feeding strategy and ponies can be brought down to be weighed on the Baileys weighbridge located at the Grand Ring end of the permanent stables.

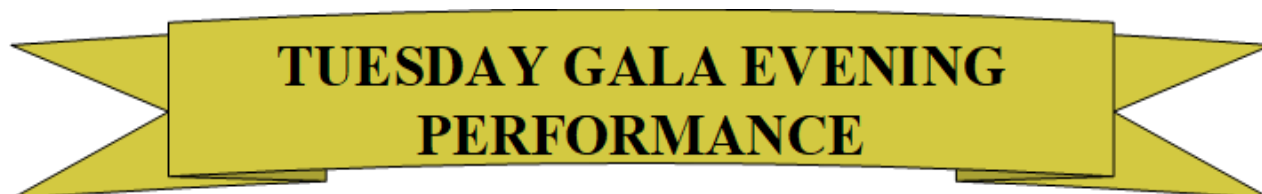
