GDPR IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Information from entry forms will be stored on a secure server and the details of entries will be published in the catalogue (if applicable). Information will be passed to our printer solely for the purpose of formulating the catalogue. Results information, including photographs, may be published (in printed form and online) both by the press, other societies and showing organisations and in the Society's publications. Information may be supplied to professional and regulatory bodies as necessary. We will not otherwise share your personal data with other third parties without your prior consent unless required to do so by law. The making of an entry is irrevocable consent for the storage and disclosure of information in this way.

Media Coverage - all attendees (which for the purposes of this condition includes horses and attendees with children) are reminded that many shows are given coverage online and in print and various other forms of media. By entering the show you accept (for yourself and on behalf of any horse or children in your care) that you/they may appear in such coverage, which may also include printed, the electronic or digital material used for the promotion of any National Pony Society show.

Accordingly, you shall have no right to object to, or demand any payment in respect of, you, your horse's or your children's inclusion in any such coverage whether produced by the Society or by third parties authorised by the Society. Furthermore by entering the show you consent (for yourself and on behalf of any children in your care) to the passing of still or moving images of you/them to third parties authorised by the Society for the purposes of the production of printed or electronic material to be used solely for the promotion of the Society.

You acknowledge that, on request, you will give any additional consents or waivers required for the unrestricted lawful use of any coverage (if any) without a request for payment or imposing any other conditions.

There is NO HOOK UP available on the showground.

All competitors are asked to respect all show officials, office staff and the security team, failing to comply will result in your removal from the showground.

- Pre-Entries:** **Postal:** Monday 14th July; **Online:** Wednesday 16th July
Entries after the closing date will not be accepted under any circumstances and will have to be entered on the day at the increased rate.
- Finals:** Ponies qualifying for Finals must be listed on the Qualified Ponies spreadsheet on the NPS website. If pre-entering online, please check the Qualified Ponies list before submitting your entry.

- On the Day** The Secretary's office will be open during the following times for on-the-day entries for all classes
Monday: 4.00pm - 7.00pm Tuesday: 6.30am - 7.00pm
Wednesday: 6.30am - 7.00pm Thursday: 6.30am - Close of Show
- On the day entries may be made **card or cash only**. Cheques cannot be accepted. Please allow good time between making an on the day entry and your class, particularly at peak times. **Refunds will not be awarded for missed classes.**
- Refunds:** Once an entry has been received no refunds of entry fees will be offered without the production of a vet/doctors certificate and will be subject to a **£25 administration charge**. All refunds will be made 30 days after the show. Stabling will not be refunded but may be resold prior to the show at cost. The NPS Office **MUST** be notified who will be taking the stable.
- Entry Fees:** Prices in brackets reflect on-the-day prices where applicable. "Miscellaneous" classes include pairs, Concours d'Elegance, tiny tots, fancy dress, unregistered pony and just backed and assisted classes. Junior refers to any unaffiliated junior class on Tuesday, and Young Handler on Thursday.

Please note Qualifying Membership is £89. This allows you to benefit from Member's Rate Entry Fees.

- Stabling:** Stables are allocated on a first come first served basis, demand is very high so to avoid disappointment please book your stable when you make your entry. Please remember, some classes start very early in the morning. We cannot guarantee being able to satisfy late requests for stables. When all the stables are booked a waiting list will be created. At our discretion, priority may be given to competitors who have already completed their entries.

Temporary Stabling may be booked online or by post at the following rates:

Permanent stabling may be booked by post or over the phone **ONLY** and is for the duration of the show strictly on a first come first served basis, at the following rates:

Please vacate all temporary stables **by 3pm on the day of departure**.

Duration and Permanent stables are available between 12pm Monday and 3pm Thursday. One and Two Night stables will be available from 5pm on the first night booked until 3pm on the last day of booking. **Temporary stables MUST be vacated by 3pm on Thursday.**

Hay/Bedding: Bedding will not be provided in the stables but is available for purchase on site in addition to hay & haylage. This can be pre-purchased with your entries or purchased on site subject to availability.
Demand has been very high in previous years so please order any bedding or fodder needed when booking your stable.

The bedding store will be open at the following times:

Monday: 12.00pm-9.00pm	Tuesday: 8.00am-9.00pm
Wednesday: 8.00am-6.00pm	Thursday: 8.00am -10.00am

Please note there will be **NO** deliveries of bedding to any stables. Competitors **MUST** collect from the Fodder Store.

Exercise: In the interests of safety ponies may only be exercised in designated Exercise Areas. These areas, for safety purposes, may be steward-monitored at peak times. Exercising is forbidden in the show/collecting rings (unless under the direction of a safety steward), as is tampering with or jumping WHP fences.

Camping/Caravans: Camping and caravan passes are available at **£8 each** in advance when making entries or through the office. Each pitch is up to 6m wide.

There is NO HOOK UP available on the showground.

Parking: While generators are permitted at Three Counties they **MUST** be switched off between **11.00pm** and **6.00am**. Anyone parking any vehicle (including private cars) without the advice and permission of NPS officials and refusing to move it to a safe area risks wheel clamping. A fine of £100, payable to the NPS office, will be required to effect release.

VACCINATIONS

Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes. Two injections for primary vaccination, not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart, are required before being eligible to compete. A first booster injection must be given within seven months after the second injection of primary vaccination. Subsequent booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than **one year**, commencing after the first booster injection; No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old. Please note any equines starting a course of vaccinations from 1st January 2024 will need to have the first 2 vaccinations 21-60 days apart and the third booster between 100-180 days.

Only primary course given. This is fine, as long as the horse has had the first two injections that make up the primary course, and the second injection was given within the last six months.

Primary course given, but first booster (due within seven months) has not yet been given. Fine if second injection was less than six months ago.

We thank all members and competitors for their cooperation with the equine influenza rules and remind all competitors to please make sure that all horses' passports are available for checking on arrival at the showground.

Forgotten passport.

Please remember there is a legal requirement to always travel your horse or pony with it's passport. Passports may be checked at any time and any horse without a passport will be sent home (this includes any travel companions).

MICROCHIPPING

Microchipping of all horses is a legal requirement in England, Scotland and Wales and are therefore a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies (excluding foals at foot) competing in NPS affiliated classes. Microchip numbers must be submitted to the relevant Passport Issuing Organisation via the relevant registration forms. It is also a legal requirement to inform the passport issuing studbook of any change of ownership or death within 30 days.

Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal. Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies.

All prize money (with the exception of the Champions and Reserve Champions of the classes in bold in the above table which will be forwarded approximately 30 days after the show) must be collected during the show. Any money not collected will be deemed a donation to the Society and will not be forwarded after the show.

Prizes in kind: Many sponsors kindly offer prizes in-kind. Prizes in-kind are awarded due to the generosity of our sponsors. However the NPS does not accept responsibility for their quality, durability, safety or suitability. Prizes will not be forwarded on after the show and are forfeited if not claimed.

Trophies: Many of our trophies are available for winners to take home and retain for one year but we ask competitors to be understanding when this is not possible due to the value or fragility of the trophy

concerned. Winners will be listed on a new roll of honour on the website instead. Winners will be able to request trophies on the day to have extra photos taken. Trophies which may be taken home are subject to a small fee to cover insurance and must be returned to the Society cleaned and engraved by 1st June the following year.

- Hats:** Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages. Hat Standards accepted as of 1st January 2024 are as follows: PAS015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 & 2023, SNELL E2016 onwards, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards.
- Hats meeting more than one standard: Some hats are badged with two or more standards. As long as a hat contains at least one compliant hat standard, then it is deemed suitable for use under NPS rules, even if it is additionally labelled with an older or out of date standard.
- Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets one of the above standards.
- Litter/Manure** Three Counties Showground disposes of all biodegradable stable manure onto farmland. You are asked to place all non-biodegradable domestic rubbish such as plastic bags, broken buckets, baling string, dog waste etc. in the receptacles provided by the Three Counties Showground.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All classes, unless otherwise stated, are subject to NPS rules and regulations as outlined in the current rule book. In addition:

- All exhibits must be in possession of Equine Passports and be registered in the Stud Book or Register of their respective Breed or Type and complying with the showing requirements of their breed society. Foals under 6 months old must have registration and passport applied for; Exmoor foals are exempt. Entries must be made in the owner's name as shown in the passport.
- In the case of a false pedigree being given on the entry form any prizes won will be forfeited.
- It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies correctly in the appropriate class. Ponies may be transferred on payment of a fee, except when measured out, once entries have been accepted.
- **Ridden Stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker on their bridle in all NPS classes excluding Horse of the Year Show Qualifiers.** For In Hand Stallions/Colts this remains advisory. These are available from the Secretary's office at a charge of £2.00.
- Grooms are required to be of smart appearance and must wear a hat whilst in the ring.
- No unauthorised use of mobile phones and/or earpieces in the ring.
- Handlers of every pony/horse eligible for The Price Family Supreme In Hand Championship will be given a qualifying card which must be handed to the Ring Steward when entering the ring for the pre-judging in order to compete for the HOYS Qualifying round at the Show.
- **All exhibitors and persons admitted to the Show Ground shall be subject to the Rules, By Laws, Orders, Regulations and Conditions of the Council of the Society.**
- Ponies may only be ridden on the showground in tack appropriate to the class they are competing in that day. All areas of the showground will be monitored.
- All Exhibits MUST be in possession of an Equine Passport. This MUST accompany the Exhibit to the show. A class may be selected at Random and ALL EXHIBITS will be required to produce their passport for entry into the class.
- The NPS reserve the right to Measure any class. For all height measurements 1cm (1/4 of an inch) will be allowed for shoes. All exhibits in classes restricted by a height limit may be measured and issued with the appropriate veterinary measurement card. Adult ponies in possession of a current J.M.B. Annual or Full Certificate will not be measured but the Certificate MUST be produced. Any pony measured out will automatically be transferred to the next height class where possible. Equine Passports will be required by the measuring officer to assist with identification. The pony's class exhibit number will be required to aid identification. Your pony will not be measured unless you produce your number. (Late entries please note, make your entry prior to presenting your pony to the measuring box).
- **Any pony/horse taking part will be liable to dope testing in accordance with the 2025 NPS Rule Book**
- **Presentations** – In all HOYS classes, ponies must be mounted for the presentation. For all NPS classes, a handler may hold the pony in the ring to collect the rosette. The pony must be present in the ring.

GENERAL REGULATIONS & SOCIETY'S POWERS

- The Show Committee reserves the right to change judges after publication of the Show Schedule. **Where possible, any changes will be sent to competitors following the close of entries, posted on the Website and Social Media.** The Council of the Society reserves to itself by its Show Committee the sole and overriding power to interpret these and any other prescribed Conditions, Regulations and Bye-Laws, or the terms of any Prize List or Schedule of Show

Conditions and to settle and determine all matters, questions or disputes in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with or incidental to the Show.

- Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their groom/assistants or riders and for the consequences of any conduct of such assistants. All persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to the orders of the Officials. There will be a zero tolerance policy regarding aggressive behaviour and any person(s) found being aggressive to any other competitor, volunteer or staff member will be removed from the showground immediately.
- Any animal not sufficiently under control shall be removed from the Show/Collecting Ring immediately at the request of a Judge/Steward of Official.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times whilst on the Showground. The Three Counties Society require dog waste to be picked up and disposed of with domestic waste, in a suitable container. Please do not place dog waste with stable manure. PLEASE TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOUR DOG.
- Bicycles, hover boards and other propelled methods of transport are strictly prohibited.

UNAUTHORISED USE OF STABLES - There will be a minimum fine of £100 levied on anyone who uses a stable without the authorisation of the Stable Manager. Refusal to pay the fine may result in suspension of membership or refusal of entries and admittance to future shows.

PROTESTS - Any member or exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any person or exhibits shall do so in writing to the Secretary and shall at the same time deposit the **sum of £50.** The protest shall be considered by a Ground Jury Panel. If on investigation the protest is not sustained, the deposit may be forfeited to the funds of the Society. All protests shall be delivered within an hour of the incident.

GENERAL DISPUTES – The NPS reserves the right to refuse entries from any person who is under exclusion or suspension by any Breed, Livestock or Show organisation. The Chairman of the Show Committee or an authorised deputy, in their absolute discretion may, without assigning any reason, refuse an entry or cancel any entry already accepted or may decline to admit to the Showground any animal or exhibitor or person or withhold any prize. Whenever under this regulation any entry is refused or cancelled, or any exhibit, exhibitor or person is refused admission or is removed, the fees paid for such entry may, at the discretion of the Show Chairman or an authorised deputy, be refunded and if refunded, shall be accepted by the exhibitor, or intending exhibitor in full satisfaction of all claims against the Society, its officers, servants or assistants.

The Chairman of the Show Committee shall have power to suspend or remove from the Showground, at the expense and risk of the person responsible, their stock or property, or anyone who shall infringe any of the Conditions or Regulations of the Society or who shall refuse to comply with any instructions given by the Stewards, or whose conduct shall in the opinion of the Chairman of the Show Committee be derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the Society or its members, or who in the opinion of the Chairman of the Show Committee have been guilty of any act or omission involving cruelty or unnecessary suffering to, or neglect of, any animal, and all forfeits, fees and charges shall be due by the person responsible before any removal from the Show Ground takes place.

Neither the Society nor any of its officers, staff or assistants shall be in any way responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatever) to exhibitors or their servants or assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought into the Showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same, or otherwise for anything else in connection with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Society's Show or Shows or to the Conditions, Regulations or By-Laws prescribed by the Society in relation thereto.

Each exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decisions of the Judges and officials of the Show who shall have power in their absolute and controlled discretion to withhold any trophy or prize for want of merit or lack of competition in any class or otherwise howsoever.

CLAIMS - Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal (including the spread of any infection or contagious disease) or article exhibited or introduced to the Showground by him or her and shall indemnify the Society and its Officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising out of his or her entry or entries in the Show.

AFFILIATIONS

British Connemara Pony Society

Breed Society rosettes are awarded to the in hand champion and the ridden winner in the Black Country Saddles section if owned by a breed society member. Membership cards to be shown in the ring.

Dales Pony Society

A Special/Performance rosette offered by the Dales Pony Society for the best registered Dales shown by an exhibitor who produces a current membership card in the ring for the in hand champion and the ridden winner in the Black Country Saddles section.

Dartmoor Pony Society

A Star Rosette is offered by the Dartmoor Pony Society to the in hand champion and a performance rosette to the ridden winner in the Black Country Saddles section if owned by a breed society member. Membership cards to be shown in the ring. A special Centenary Dartmoor Championship will be held on Thursday 7th August. Please see championship 107 for details.

Exmoor Pony Society

Exmoor Pony of the Year Qualifier: The two highest placed Adult and Youngstock Exmoor ponies in hand and ridden will qualify for 'The Exmoor of the Year'. The Exmoor Pony Society will offer a special qualifying rosette. The final will take place at the EPS Midland Area Show at Rugby Riding Club CV22 5EP.

Fell Pony Society

Breed Society rosettes are awarded to the in hand champion and the ridden winner in the Black Country Saddles section if owned by a breed society member. Membership cards to be shown in the ring.

Highland Pony Society

Ponies must be registered in the full body of the Highland Pony Society Stud Book (including appendices A, B & C). All competing Highland pony stallions (In Hand, Ridden, WHP etc) aged 4yrs and over must be licensed with the Highland Pony Society. Junior handlers and riders showing Highland ponies will eligible for special rosettes.

New Forest Pony Breeding and Cattle Society

A Star Rosette is offered by the New Forest Pony Society to the in hand champion and a Best of Breed Rosette to the ridden winner in the Black Country Saddles section if owned by a breed society member. Membership cards to be shown in the ring.

Shetland Pony Studbook Society (only applicable to the Ridden Shetland Black Country Saddles class and the Shetland in hand breed classes)

1. Classes must be confined to SPS-BS registered ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.
2. Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show.
3. To enter a stallion in ANY class (in hand or performance) at an affiliated show, entire males aged 4years and over must have an "S" number and have been successfully through either the SPS-BS Stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPS-BS Voluntary Veterinary Examination. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In hand colts/stallions of two years or over must be shown bitted and are advised to display a colt or stallion bridle badge.
3. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-hand classes. For Health & safety purposes judges and exhibitors must remain standing whilst in the ring. KNEELING IS NOT PERMITTED.. Hard hats conforming to the current British safety standards must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

SSADL

DIRECT ROUTE QUALIFIERS – Are open to Members and Non-members HOWEVER, to claim the LIHS ticket a competitor MUST already be a 2025 member. The members MUST produce the membership card or a covering letter from the SSAD Show office to be able to claim the LIHS Ticket. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same for the Grand Final. No substitutions will be accepted. For a competitor to be eligible to compete at the LIHS Senior Showing Grand Final at the XCELL, ALL ponies/horses MUST meet the current FEI Vaccination Regulations.

NOTE -once a competitor has qualified for LIHS in the ridden section, they are not allowed to qualify in the in-hand section and vice versa on the same animal.

IN – HAND CLASSES Should a competitor win a class and not wish to go into the championship then they must tell the judge/steward. In this situation the 2nd & 3rd will go to the Championship. Competitors MUST produce both the above cards at the ring side before entry no cards no entry

No Spurs with the exception to senior side saddle riders. No Galloping or canter extensions, No Wearing of Face/Body Jewellery with the exception to the earring used by competitors with health problems. Foals are NOT permitted in SSADL Classes. For In-Hand Classes- Minimum age of handler = 11 years old. First Ridden ponies/riders will be asked after the initial walk round to come into the centre of the ring. First Ridden Competitors will only canter in their individual shows. Lead Rein & First Ridden competitors: Strip section both lead rein and First Ridden rider MUST stay mounted.

STALLIONS- Either for In Hand or Ridden classes, Competitors Must be 16 years of age or over. Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given. Grooms must be 16 years of age and correctly Dressed. Judges are NOT allowed to groom for a SSADL competitor. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same from qualifier to Grand Finals, unless special circumstances should arise, then it will be left to the discretion of the Directors and Advisory Committee to oversee this rule if required.

The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same whether side saddle or astride from First/Second or Direct Route Qualifiers and Grand Final. All competitors must acquaint themselves with SSADL rules before entering, the rulebook can be found at www.seniorshowinganddressage.co.uk

SSADL age badges must be worn by members, failure to do will deem disqualification. All stallions must wear the SSADL stallion badge

National Pony Society Working Dressage Group

Any registered British Riding Pony, pure or part bred Mountain & Moorland, or ponies registered with the Sports Pony Studbook, achieving a score of 59% or higher in the Prelim and Novice dressage tests, will qualify for the 2026 Championship Final.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW- GENERAL WORDING

All Horse of the Year Show (HOYS) qualifiers are also subject to the following conditions:

- These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk.
- These classes are qualifying classes for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 8th – 12th October 2025. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.
- Riders and Owners must be members of NPS, UKPH, The Showing Register or BSPS. Riders and Owners competing in M&M classes may also be a member of their respective breed society.
- **Qualification for all plaited pony classes will go no lower than 5th place.**
- **Qualification for all M&M classes will go no lower than 3rd place.**
- These classes are Horse of the Year Show qualifiers, all data given upon entry of these classes is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit www.grandstandentries.com.

For plaited pony classes 1-10, 143-145 marks will be awarded in the following way:

- Manners & Way of Going – 50 Marks Maximum
- Conformation, Type & Freedom of Action – 50 Marks Maximum
- In the case of equality, the pony with the highest Manners & Way of Going mark will be deemed the winner. If there is still equality at this point, then the judges' decision will be final.

For mountain and moorland classes 228-229, 259-270 & 301-303 marks will be awarded in the following way:

- Show, Freedom of Action – 50 Marks Maximum
- Breed Type & Conformation – 50 Marks Maximum
- In the case of equality the pony with the highest Show, Freedom of Action mark will be deemed the winner. If there is still equality at this point then the judges' decision will be final.

Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal. Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies.

All Animals competing in Height Restricted HOYS classes will be required to be in possession of a current/valid JMB height certificate within 28 days of the notification of qualification from HOYS or by the closing date of HOYS entries, whichever is sooner. Failure to do so may result in qualification of the pony being removed, at the discretion of GML. All M&M ponies in Open and Junior classes also need a JMB except breeds without an upper height limit as part of their breed specification

HOYS The Price Family Supreme In Hand

The following class is a qualifier for the Price Family Supreme In Hand Championship, N.E.C., Birmingham, 8th – 12th October 2025. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony In Hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses). The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete, provided it has not already won a qualifying round in 2025. Show Hunter Pony Breeding, Show Pony Breeding, Show Pony Youngstock, Show Pony Broodmare, Show Pony Stallion, Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland & Welsh Sections A, B,C & D. Anglo/Part Bred Arab, Part Bred Welsh, Hacks, Riding Horse, Sports Pony In Hand, Part Bred Native In Hand, Home Produced Show Pony, Home Produced Show Hunter Pony & M&M Home Produced. If the Champion has already qualified or is ineligible then the Reserve Champion of that section may come forward, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified or are ineligible then the section will not be represented in this qualifying round.

Foal champions are not eligible. Geldings Four years old and over are not eligible. Each section represented must consist of a minimum of 2 classes and a Championship. There will be no direct entry into the Price Family Supreme In Hand Championship Qualifier; all animals must be a section Champion or Reserve Champion as applicable.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the qualification will not pass down to the Reserve in the 2nd and subsequent sections.

Championship: The Price Family Supreme In Hand Horse of the Year Show qualifying competition

Prizes: Champion: £100.00

Price Family Champion Rosette & Sash

Reserve: £50.00

Price Family Reserve Champion Rosette

Prize money will be paid out after the Final by Grandstand Media Ltd to all Champions who come forward at the Horse of the Year Show. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register (for ridden ponies only); the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part breeds are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the Final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern. Ridden British Riding Pony classes and the Ottergayle qualifiers do not require membership.



The first 3 ponies, owned by an NPS member, in each of the qualifying classes will go forward to the final. Where these ponies have already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than fifth place.

NPS/WTJ Insurance Brokers Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) may wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. All qualifying ponies will receive a qualification card. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeited.

NOISE PREVENTION is strictly governed by Three Counties Association in conjunction with their contracted audio company and sound system. Whilst we have asked for all areas of showground to be covered by the Public Address System there are some areas which unfortunately cannot be reached. **IT IS THE EXHIBITORS RESPONSIBILITY** to make sure that they can hear all announcements and reach their Ring on time. 


